What Is A Website Privacy Policy?

A website privacy policy (or data protection policy) outlines the procedures our organisation have created to protect our visitors' personal data. This Website Privacy Policy is General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) compliant. As well as reassuring our online customers and users, it also ensures that our organisation have their permission to store cookies on their computer. This website privacy policy aims to make our organisation internet business compliant with UK and EU data privacy laws and covers key issues such as use of personal data, links to other websites, passwords and security.

About This Website Privacy Policy

We take your privacy seriously and are committed to maintaining the privacy and security of information you provide to us, and the choices you have regarding our collection and use of your information. This Website Privacy Policy applies to information we collect about you through this website and when you otherwise communicate with us. By visiting our website you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this Website Privacy Policy.

We process your personal data on the basis that you have provided your consent for us to do so for the purposes set out below when you submitted your personal data to us. If you do withdraw your consent, we may still be able to process some of the data that you have provided to us on other grounds.

We have a philosophy here about the way we use your consent to be contacted by us (if you give us that consent). If you hear from us, we will always aim to be respectful, relevant and appropriate. If at any time you don't feel we've lived up to our philosophy, please let us know straight away by getting in touch with us.

Information We May Collect About You

We may collect and process the following data:

1. Information you give to us

You may give us information about you by filling in forms (e.g. on our 'Request Further Information' page), or by contacting us in any other form via the website. The information you give to us may include:

- a. your name and title;
- b. contact information, including telephone number and email address;

2. Information we collect about you

Each time you visit our website, we may automatically collect the following information: web usage information (e.g. IP address), your login information, browser type and version, time zone setting, operating system and platform; and information about your visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URLs) clickstream to, through and from www.i-path.biz (including date and time); time on page, page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks and mouse-overs).

Cookie Policy

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users and to improve your experience on our website. When you visit the website we will ask you whether you agree to our use of cookies.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a text file containing small amounts of information which is downloaded to your device when you access a website. The text file is then sent back to our server each time your browser requests a page from the server. This enables us to operate the website more effectively and load the website in such a way as to

reflect your personal preferences based on your previous browsing on the website, as well as keywords we may be able to gather from URLs of webpages from which you accessed the website.

What cookies do we use?

We use the following cookies:

1. Analytical and performance cookies.

We may use analytics service providers for website traffic analysis and reporting. Analytics service providers generate statistical and other information about the use of the website by using cookies. They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how often visitors return to the website, how long they stay and how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. The information generated relating to the website may be used to create reports about the use of the website and the analytics service provider will also store this information.

2. Advertising and targeting cookies

These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed to other websites. We will use this information to try and make our website and other websites that you visit more relevant to your interests.

3. Functionality cookies

We may use functional cookies that allow us to remember choices you have made in relation to the website so as to provide a more personalised experience and enhanced user experience by delivering content specific to your interests.

4. Third party cookies

We try and make it easy to share content and to see what content is popular on those networks. We add buttons to allow people to easily share to those networks. When we include these social 'plugins', it gives those sites the flexibility to use cookies. They can't read any cookies we set from our website, and we can't read any cookies they set, but it lets them do the same kind of traffic measuring that we do on the rest of the website, and it also lets them know whether you're logged in. Other websites and services (including, for example, advertising networks, providers of external services like web traffic analysis services and content recommendation engines) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

How do I turn cookies off?

If you would like to opt out of cookies, you can change the settings on your internet browser to reject cookies. For more information please consult the "Help" section of your browser or visit www.aboutcookies.org or www.allaboutcookies.org. Please note that if you do set your browser to reject cookies, you may not be able to use all of the features of our website.

How We Will Use Your Information

We may use your information for the following purposes:

- to respond to any query that you may submit to us;
- to ensure that our website's content is presented in the most effective manner for you and your computer;
- to customise the website according to your interests;

- to administer the website and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey responses;
- to allow you to participate in interactive features of our service when you choose to do so; as part of our efforts to keep the website safe and secure;
- to measure or understand the effectiveness of advertising we serve to you and others, and to deliver relevant advertising to you;
- to comply with the law;
- as we feel is necessary to prevent illegal activity or to protect our interests.

Disclosure Of Your Information

We do not share, rent or sell our user's details to any other organisation or individual.

Storage Of Your Personal Data

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside of the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or one of our suppliers. By using the website, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Website Privacy Policy.

We follow strict security procedures as to how your personal information is stored and used, and who sees it, to help stop any unauthorised person getting hold of it. All personal information you register on this website will be located behind a firewall. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure and although we do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data. So we cannot accept any liability for the loss, theft or misuse of the personal information which you have registered on the website if there is a security breach.
